ABOUT THIS COURSE

This class explores the process organizations undertake when doing long-range planning and applies it to labor unions. Students will learn the components of a strategic plan and the process for developing one with an eye toward developing a strategic plan relevant to their situations. All of this lays out solid considerations for working with your teams and moving your local forward.

This class, for currently serving Local Union Officers, Officials, Trustees, and Board members is a virtual complement to the in-person IATSE Officer Institute. It is focused on effective leadership principles and tools to help attendees to build a high-capacity local union, effectively represent workers, communicate clearly, and set and achieve long term goals.

ATTEND INDEPENDENTLY AND AT YOUR OWN PACE

Learning is asynchronous! That means that during the week of the course, students will complete the lessons on their own schedule, for a total time of approximately 6-8 hours over the course of the week. Lessons include short readings, videos, recorded PowerPoints, quizzes, and discussion boards where reflective questions will be posed and students post responses and comments for the instructor and classmates.
