At least 1 of the wardrobe personnel must know how to operate a sewing machine and know how to alter costumes with it. They must have a clear understanding of how clothing is constructed. They must also know how to sew by hand.

The laundry technician will be on exactly the same time schedule as the dressers during load in, continuity, and show calls. They will not stay late after performances. They will be called to weekly work calls.
