



IATSE Yellow & White Cards for Pink Contract Productions

What is a Yellow or White card?

The Yellow Card is the official means of setting minimum staffing levels in each city in which a Pink Contract production tours to. A White Card is information that is specific to Wardrobe and Hair & Make-Up.

At the start of every new tour, the Head Carpenter shall fill out the Yellow Card form to “set” their card.

The Wardrobe Supervisor shall fill out the White Card.

The blank forms can be found on the IA website.

- These forms shall be completed no later than the second tour stop after the city in which the production teched.
- The Yellow Card form shall be signed by both the Head Carpenter and either the local union or an IA Representative.
- This information will be published on the IATSE website. If you do not wish to share your contact info, please leave those sections blank.

All completed forms should be returned to the Stagecraft Department Contract Administrator, Sheena Crespo screspo@iatse.net.

Once received the Yellow and White Card information will be uploaded to the IATSE website for local unions to view and assist in staffing the show with local labor. Should a revision to the card be necessary to increase the minimum numbers or change the remarks, please complete a new form. A reduction in the minimum numbers requires a new form as well as permission from the Stagecraft Department. White Card information can be changed at any time.
