



ITEMS FOR DISASTER RECOVERY

Below is a sample “market list” of items usually needed after a catastrophic water event. It is by no means complete. Please add to if you think of other items.

HEAVY EQUIPMENT (non-expendable)

- Generator
- Heavy extension cords
- Solar panels for recharging cellphones and tablets
- Circular saw
- Chainsaws
- Fans
- Screw gun
- Ladders
- Portable lights
- Dehumidifiers
- Pop-up tent w/spikes and sandbags

IMMEDIATE NEED (expendable)

- Water – pint bottles
- MRE
- Toilet paper
- Paper towel
- Handi-wipes –sanitizing
- Hand sanitizer – small bottles
- Toothpaste
- Toothbrushes
- Disinfecting hand soap
- Feminine hygiene supplies
- Diapers
- Baby food
- Pet food
- Bleach
- Batteries – various sizes
- Water purifying tablets

STABLIZATION (expendable)

- Blue tarps – various sizes
- Visquene
- Duct tape
- 1” x 4” lumber
- ½” plywood
- Metal levels or long straight metal – cutting drywall
- Sledgehammers
- Pry bars / wrecking bars
- Chalk Lines – to mark drywall cuts
- Drywall screws – various lengths
- Roofing nails with caps
- Parachute cord
- Rope & string
- Mat knives / drywall knives
- Ratchet straps

REMEDIATION (expendable)

- N95/N100 particulate masks
- Tyvek suits – several sizes
- Rubber gloves – various sizes
- Hard hats
- Eye protection
- Trash bags – heavy-duty large
- Compactor bags
- 5-gallon buckets
- Cleaning supplies
- Disinfecting products
- Mold remediation products
- Scrub brushes
- Sponges
- Shovels – flat or scoop - various sizes
- Mops, Brooms and dust pans
- Squeegees – hand and handle version
