



ITEMS FOR DISASTER RECOVERY

Below is a sample “market list” of items usually needed after a catastrophic water event. It is by no means complete. Please add to if you think of other items.

HEAVY EQUIPMENT (non-expendable)

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| ☐ Generator | ☐ Fans |
| ☐ Heavy extension cords | ☐ Screw gun |
| ☐ Solar panels for recharging cellphones and tablets | ☐ Ladders |
| ☐ Circular saw | ☐ Portable lights |
| ☐ Chainsaws | ☐ Dehumidifiers |
| | ☐ Pop-up tent w/spikes and sandbags |

IMMEDIATE NEED (expendable)

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| ☐ Water – pint bottles | ☐ Disinfecting hand soap |
| ☐ MRE's | ☐ Feminine hygiene supplies |
| ☐ Toilet paper | ☐ Diapers |
| ☐ Paper towel | ☐ Baby food |
| ☐ Handi-wipes –sanitizing | ☐ Pet food |
| ☐ Hand sanitizer – small bottles | ☐ Bleach |
| ☐ Toothpaste | ☐ Batteries – various sizes |
| ☐ Toothbrushes | ☐ Water purifying tablets |

STABLIZATION (expendable)

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| ☐ Blue tarps – various sizes | ☐ Pry bars / wrecking bars |
| ☐ Visquene | ☐ Chalk Lines – to mark drywall cuts |
| ☐ Duct tape | ☐ Drywall screws – various lengths |
| ☐ 1" x 4" lumber | ☐ Roofing nails with caps |
| ☐ ½" plywood | ☐ Parachute cord |
| ☐ Metal levels or long straight metal – for cutting drywall | ☐ Rope & string |
| ☐ Sledgehammers | ☐ Mat knives / drywall knives |
| | ☐ Ratchet straps |

REMEDIATION (expendable)

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| ☐ N95/N100 particulate masks | ☐ Cleaning supplies |
| ☐ Tyvek suits – several sizes | ☐ Disinfecting products |
| ☐ Rubber gloves – various sizes | ☐ Mold remediation products |
| ☐ Hard hats | ☐ Scrub brushes |
| ☐ Eye protection | ☐ Sponges |
| ☐ Trash bags – heavy-duty large | ☐ Shovels – flat or scoop - various sizes |
| ☐ Compactor bags | ☐ Mops, Brooms and dust pans |
| ☐ 5-gallon buckets | ☐ Squeegees – hand and handle version |
