So, what types of things are needed? At this point, basically anything used to clean-up. Below is a list of some items that are useful:

| ☐ Rubber gloves – various sizes | ☐ Shovels (flat blade or snow) | ☐ Hand sanitizer – small bottles |
| ☐ Hard hats | ☐ Brooms and dust pans | ☐ Toothpaste |
| ☐ Eye protection | ☐ Squeegees – hand and handle versions | ☐ Toothbrushes |
| ☐ Trash bags – heavy-duty large | ☐ Parachute cord | ☐ Disinfecting hand soap |
| ☐ Compactor bags | ☐ Rope | ☐ Feminine hygiene supplies |
